### The Meaning of Memorial Day

Memorial Day is observed on the last Monday of May. It honors the members of the U.S. military who died in American wars. One of the biggest Memorial Day traditions is for the president or vice president to give a speech. Another is for the president or vice president to lay a wreath on soldiers' graves in the largest U.S. military burial ground, Arlington National Cemetery, in Virginia.

Most towns have local Memorial Day celebrations. Here are some ways you can honor those who have served our country.

- Put flags or flowers on the graves of people who served in wars.
- Fly the U.S. flag at half-mast until noon.
- Visit monuments dedicated to soldiers, sailors, and marines.
- Participate in the National Moment of Remembrance at 3 p.m. local time.
- March in a parade.
